We kindly ask you not to use any new definitions or packages, except for possible additional language options to the babel package.

Since we are going to combine all contributions into a single file we kindly ask you to use the following scheme for labels and file names. All labels (e.g., to your references (cf. [1])) and file names (e.g., images or bibtex files) must start with first three letters of the surname of the (co-)author who submits the contribution, followed by an underscore “_”. Here we use **Aut_** for this purpose.

The text *must* not exceed one page with font and margins fixed in this template. It may contain tables (cf. Table 1) and pictures (cf. Figure 1).
